

## THE "POPIA" ACT.

(Protection of Personal Information Act, No.4 of 2013)

The Rand Athletic Club (RAC) is obliged to comply with the above Act. We now require members consent for the Club to use and store their Personal information on the Club Data Base.

The Personal Information we keep is:

First Name, Surname	I.D Number.	Licence Number.
Mobile Phone Number.	e Mail Address	Date of Joining the Club.
Subscriptions paid or due.		

This information is updated, where necessary, on receipt of the Members annual Licence Renewal Form.

The licence renewal form is relayed to our Provincial office for transfer to the National Athletic Parent body who in turn use it to update the Athlete Insurance Policy and their own records.

RAC use the members personal addresses to publish communications such as the NewsFlash and other relevant information via the Internet or posts on Social Media pages like Facebook, Instagram and Twitter. Members photographs are, at times, also included in these communications.
